What is Trailblazer Express?



Undergraduate Admission Updates

TM CONTRACTOR OF THE PARTY OF T

- Continue to be SAT/ACT test optional
- Do not require an application fee or waiver
- Assured admission for students who are either ranked in the top 30% or have a 3.0 or higher unweighted GPA (4.0 scale)
 - Students with GPAs between a 2.25 and 2.999 can be considered through individual holistic review. Must submit Resume, Personal Statement and Letter(s) of Recommendation.



Undergraduate Admission Updates



Key Dates:

- December 13th Indicate commitment to participate in Cohort 3
- January 17th Submit student data after mid-year grades
- February Letters go to students and homes by the first week
- May 1st Final priority consideration for scholarships and Promise
- July 1st Submit Final Transcript for students attending UNT Dallas
