



Robert Mong Endowed Scholarship Instructions – 2025-26

APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

- Meet the minimum entrance and continuing academic performance standards of UNT Dallas;
- Must be graduating in May 2026 or after;
- Financial need, as determined by completion of the federal (FAFSA) or state (TASFA) financial aid applications;
- Maintain full-time undergraduate program enrollment (12 or more hours) at the university;
- Cumulative GPA of 2.75 or higher in collegiate coursework;
- Additional consideration given to students who demonstrate strong writing skills within this application.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP:

A **one-time** scholarship of **\$5,000** will be awarded. The scholarship will be disbursed to the student as follows:

- Fall 2025 semester: \$2,500
- Spring 2026 semester: \$2,500
