Subject: Assaults in Downtown Dallas

The University of North Texas Dallas Police Department is issuing a timely warning to inform the Law Center campus community of recent assaults occurring in the downtown Dallas area. According to the Dallas Police Department (DPD), an unknown male has been randomly approaching and assaulting pedestrians without provocation. Victims report that the suspect has been knocking individuals unconscious.

At this time, DPD has not apprehended the suspect, and the investigation is ongoing. We urge all members of our community to remain vigilant, avoid walking alone when possible, and immediately report any suspicious activity to the police.

For your safety:

- Be aware of your surroundings at all times.
- Walk in groups, especially after dark.
- Utilize well-lit and populated areas.
- If you witness or experience any incidents, call 911 or campus security immediately.
