Notes/Comments:

(1) The Student Success Course Requirement (EDUC 1300) is satisfied through successful completion of EMSP 1438 - Introduction to Advanced Practice.

(2) MATH 1314- College Algebra or higher; MATH 1342 – Statistics preferred.

- The program capstone is satisfied by earning a passing score on the National Registry Paramedic Exam or obtaining Texas Department of State Health Services Certification as a paramedic.
- Students may receive college credits for state licensure through the Prior Learning Assessment program (see advisor)

Courses are not required for the Emergency Medical Services AAS degree at LSC; however, they will apply to the core curriculum required to earn the BAAS at UNT Dallas.

Student may transfer up to 42 of 44 credit hours of Technical Credit at LSC and 42 credit hours of core curriculum to UNT Dallas.

Program Specific Information:

Bachelor of Applied Science in Emergency Services Administration

Program Specific Requirements:

- Completion of the degree requires 120 credit hours including 42 hours of Texas Common Core Curriculum.
- 36 credit hours must be advanced coursework, 3XXX or 4XXX.
- 30 credit hours must be completed at UNT Dallas, including 24 advanced hours.

Program Admission Requirements:

- Cumulative GPA 2.0 or higher.

Transfer of Credit and Student Benefits:

- Student may transfer up to 42 hours of specialization credit hours and up to 42 hours of core curriculum for a total of 84 hours of transfer credit.
- Courses at UNT Dallas may be completed online through distance learning.

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
